4. Plan & Place Your Order

Secure your design, set your timeline, and get ready to build.

Once your design is finalized and you're ready to move forward with your investment, it's time to secure your project and get on the schedule.

Here's What This Step Includes:

- Review and approve your plans and quote
- Send in your 25% initial investment to secure your spot in our production schedule.
- Work with your builder (or us) to finalize your construction timeline.
- Secure permits, land prep, financing, and any additional needs.

Ward Option: Not ready to build just yet? You can purchase just the plans for 3% of your home package price, which gets credited towards your purchase of your home for up to 12 months.

5. Build & Deliver

Precision-milled materials that are pre-cut and numbered. Delivered on time and built to last.

Once your design is finalized and your purchase agreement is signed, your custom log home package goes into production at our mill in Houlton, ME.

What You Can Expect:

- Your log home materials package ships in as little as 8-12 weeks once you have provided final approval of plans and your initial investment has been received.
- Your logs are pre-cut and numbered, and other items are labeled and ready for assembly. This makes your builder's job easier and faster.
- Your log package includes:
 - o Floor system, Log walls, interior wall framing with T&G, roof system, T&G for ceilings
 - Loft floor framing with 2x T&G V-match flooring
 - Andersen windows, Therma-Tru exterior doors, porch and deck materials, and more
- Your builder or you, if you are building it yourself, uses our 110-page detailed Construction
 Manual along with well-detailed construction drawings.

6. Support

Budgeting Basics:

- Log home packages can range from \$40,000 (camps) to \$150,000 and up.
- Be sure to factor in site costs: Foundation, driveway, well/septic.
- Labor: General Contractor vs. Do-it-yourself labor.
- Plumbing, heating, and electrical.
- Interior Finishes: Cabinets, flooring, fixtures, etc.

Common Questions:

- **Do I need land first?** No, but we will help you plan based on location
- Can I modify a floor plan? Yes, move walls, change sizes, adjust windows, and more. Or go completely custom at no additional cost.
- How long does it take? As a general rule, plan to reach out to us at least six months to a year before you want to begin building. This will give you time to make thoughtful, unhurried decisions concerning layout and finishes.
